A short bio

Alkyone is a singer-songwriter, born and bred in the mountains of northern Greece.

Though she started at the age of six and later went on to study classical piano, it wasn't until much later that she embraced her own path, following the craft of songwriting.

Influenced by her father's deep love for folk music, Alkyone began experimenting with traditional songs, weaving a distinct folklore thread into her musical identity. Her sound blends indie-pop, cinematic textures, and folk influences, resulting in songs that feel both ethereal and grounded.

Her years as a choir member led her to incorporate haunting vocals and backgrounds into her songs, stating that "there's something so extremely primal and powerful in a choir, that it just feels right doing it."

Growing up in a small town surrounded by mountains and rivers nurtured in her an immense love for nature and birds. Her stage name, Alkyone, is a tribute to a dream she often had, in which she was a bird.

Alkyone often experiments with traditional songs, intertwining characteristic folk sounds with cinematic, electronic, and indie elements.

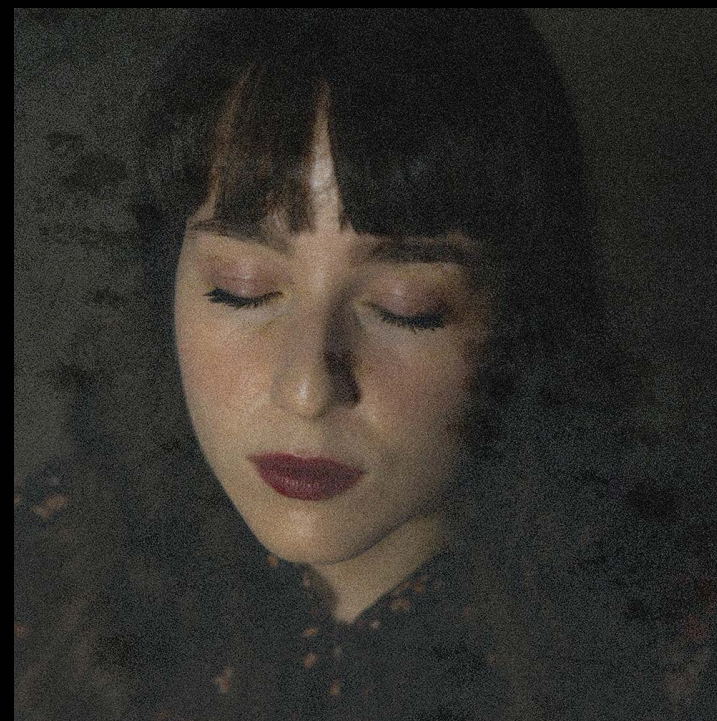
She adds new orchestral parts and melodies, turning the old into something new while preserving its core and soul.

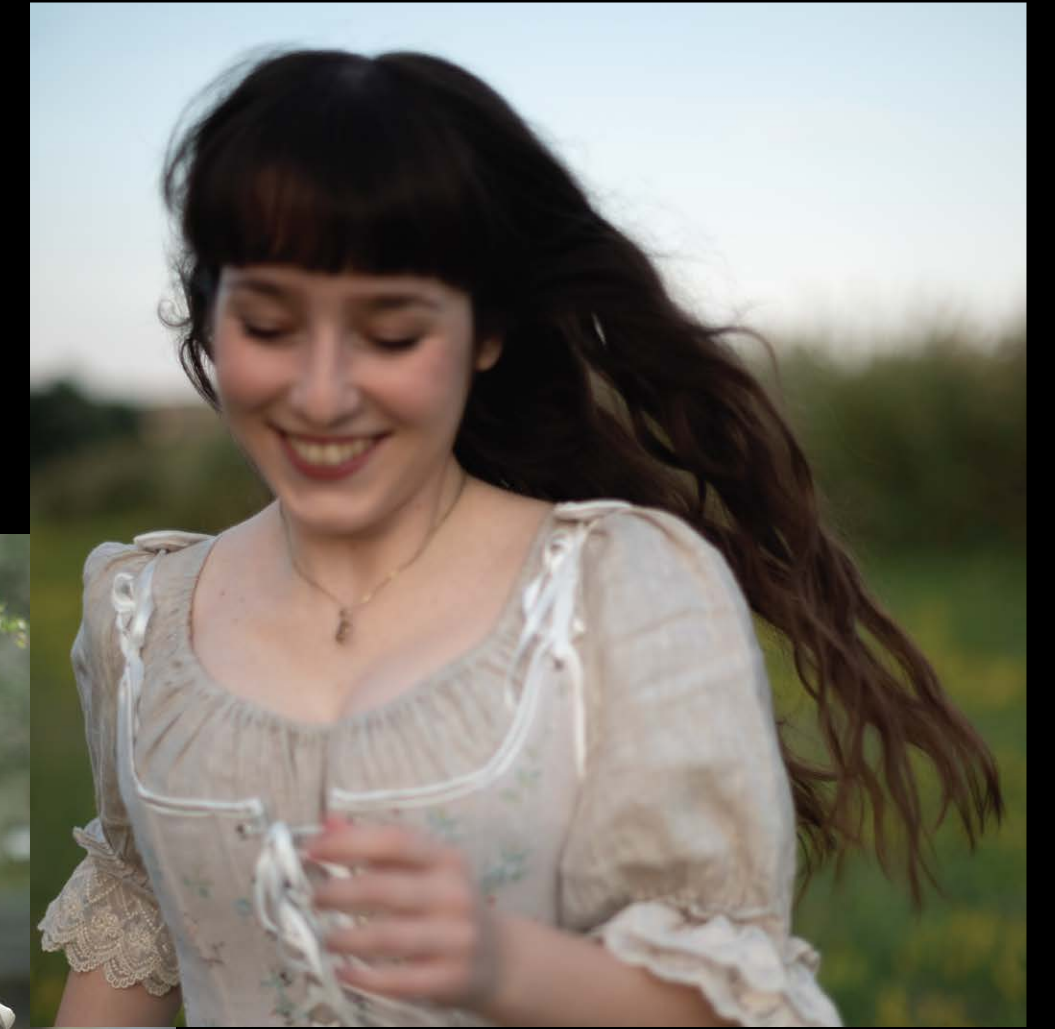
